Doron Perk is a choreographer, dancer, educator, and artistic director. Studied at the Jerusalem Academy for Music and Dance (2003-8) and danced in the Croatian National Ballet in Split (2008-10), Compañía Nacional de Danza in Madrid (2010-13), the Batsheva Ensemble in Tel Aviv (2013-15), and ZviDance in New York City (2016-2022). Doron is a certified Gaga movement teacher, Super Chill Ballet founder, and an adjunct professor at NYU Tisch. In 2022, Doron started More Fish Dance Company to focus on his choreography and community. Other achievements include being listed in Dance Magazine's "Best Performers of 2016" and a Bessie Award nomination in 2022.

The Moment (2024) is a fully improvised experimental movement performance that explores the juxtaposition of structure versus freedom as a generative tool to create vibrant and authentic art. Through a combination of free-form improvisation and live phrasework creation, an ensemble of unique dancers/choreographers takes turns leading, following, directing, and interpreting movements. It shares the process of dancemaking with an audience as a metaphor for an empathetic and creative society.



OPEN STUDIOS

Free movement sessions led by different artists every week. Artists have the freedom to experiment with any creative idea in a casual environment and participants gain a unique workshop experience. "Open Studios" has been running since January 2023 and became the company's flagship project, creating space for our community to meet, experiment, and learn from each other.

SHOW & TELL

A quarterly opportunity to share and watch works in progress in a casual studio environment. The first "Show and Tell" took place on February 26th, 2024.

Artists share up to 10 minutes of new work and we end with a communal feedback session. The goal is to strengthen the artistic community by creating a space for sharing, feedback, and collaboration in a supportive environment where artists can thrive.
